

# WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE DAY OF SURGERY

## PRE-ARRIVAL



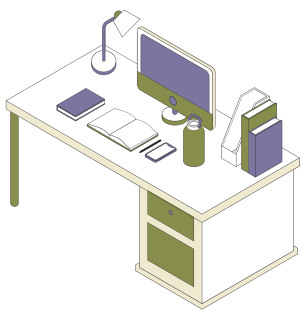
Make sure to read our “Prepare your Child for Surgery” information to feel ready

## PARKING

Park in our designated patient pick-up spots on the side of the building. If it is not available don't worry, we will let you know when you it becomes available!



## CHECK-IN



Check in with our front desk. We will schedule a 1-2 week post op appointment, update any consent forms and collect copays. Please encourage your child to use the restroom. You will be given post-op instructions to read over while waiting.

## SURGERY TIME

Our nurse will escort your child back to surgery while you remain in the waiting room until their surgery is finished.



## RECOVERY

Once surgery is completed your child will be assisted to our recovery room. We will bring you to them and you will remain in recovery until your child is ready to be discharged by the doctor.

Please do not encourage them to talk as this will dislodge the gauze that they have in their mouth and prolong the bleeding! They must keep constant pressure by biting down on the gauze!

While in recovery, we will go over the post-op instructions you were given at check in!

## POST-OP PRESCRIPTIONS



Your Doctor will give prescriptions that you must take to the pharmacy to get filled.

## ONCE HOME

It is recommended that you or another adult stay with your child for the remainder of the day after surgery due to the effects of anesthesia and need for assistance.
